- You must have a driver present at all times at the facility who will take you home.
- *Public transportation or cabs are not allowed.*
- **STAY HYDRATED. DRINK ADDITIONAL CLEAR LIQUIDS DURING THIS PREP**

## Blood Thinner Medications:

*If you take a blood thinner, notify Internal Medicine Scheduling Dept. for your Special Instructions (Coumadin, Plavix, Brilinta, Eliquis, Lovenox, Xarelto, Aggrenox, Effient, Pradaxa, Zontivity or Savaysa).*

**You may stay on your Aspirin.**

## PREP INSTRUCTIONS:

- **Purchase from your pharmacy:**
  - Dulcolax tablets
  - Miralax 238 gm bottle
  - Gatorade 64 oz. (NO RED OR PURPLE) or Crystal Light 64 oz. (NO RED OR PURPLE) if diabetic
- **START YOUR PREP THE DAY BEFORE YOUR PROCEDURE ON \_\_\_\_\_(DATE)**
  - **AT 9:00 a.m. START A CLEAR LIQUID DIET** Please see additional page "Just what is a Clear Liquid". Do **NOT** drink any dairy products, smoothies or anything containing artificial red dye.
  - **If you are a Diabetic**, take ½ your usual dose of insulin/diabetes medication while on this Clear Liquid diet.
  - **At 4:00 p.m.**, take TWO (2) Dulcolax tablets along with 12 oz. of Clear Liquids.
  - **At 6:00 p.m.**, mix the bottle of Miralax in the Gatorade or Crystal Light (NOT red or purple color). Shake until mixed. **DRINK ½ OF THIS PREP. REFRIGERATE the REST.**
- **DAY OF YOUR PROCEDURE \_\_\_\_\_(DATE)**
  - **5 HOURS PRIOR TO YOUR ARRIVAL TO THE FACILITY DRINK THE REMAINING ½ of the prep.**
  - **STOP DRINKING LIQUIDS 3 HOURS BEFORE YOU ARRIVE AT THE FACILITY OR THE PROCEDURE WILL BE CANCELLED AND RESCHEDULED. NOT EVEN A SIP!!!**
  - **IF YOU ARE A DIABETIC**
    - **Do NOT take insulin** or other diabetes medication the morning of the procedure. Please check your blood sugar the morning of the procedure and report it to the nurse.
  - **IF YOU ARE ON BLOOD PRESSURE OR HEART MEDICATION**
    - Take your blood pressure and/or heart medication as prescribed **4 HOURS BEFORE** the procedure.
